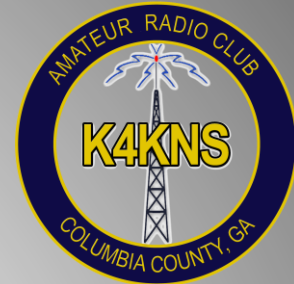
BOD Meeting Update

 - All Committees should be coordinating meetings on their own with the Co-Directors providing updates at the General Meetings and issuing any requests for the members to vote on.



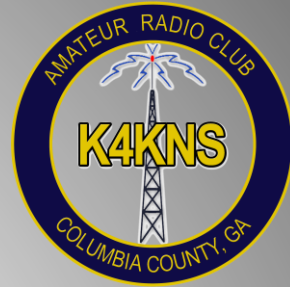

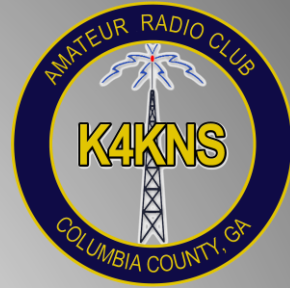
MEETING AGENDA ITEMS
