ARCCC, Inc. Announcements, March 2020

In order to protect the health and well-being of our members and their families, ARCCC, Inc. will not hold a general meeting in March.

Please read below for informaton and announcements that would normally be provided during our monthly meeting.

The <u>Amateur Radio Club of Columbia County, Inc.</u> normally meets on the fourth Tuesday of each month at the Columbia County Emergency Operations Center located at 650-B Ronald Reagan Drive, Evans, GA. The meeting begins at 7 PM, with fellowship starting at 6:30. We will resume our monthly meetings once it is deemed safe by public health officials to hold public gatherings.

During this period of social distancing and self-quarantine, someone from the

ARCCC, Inc. Board of Directors and Committee Co-Directors will be available during the "rag chew" portion of our Monday evening nets to address questions and comments from club members. We are tentatively planning to hold a general meeting in April. If it is still recommended that we not hold public gatherings at that time, which seems likely, we will come up with a process to use the repeater and online resources for a virtual meeting, so we can carry out essential club business. Until we have a forum for motions and votes, we will continue to pay for services essential to maintaining club operations.

ARCCC, Inc. membership dues are normally paid during the month of March every year. If you have already paid your 2020 dues we thank you for continuing your membership. Due to the unanticipated disruption of our meeting schedule from COVID-19, the Board of Directors has extended dues collection through the end of April. Repeater and Net Updates

The ARCCC, Inc. Repeater Committee has been hard at work and have recently installed GE Mastr II Repeaters on the 145.410 and 444.675 repeaters which are located at Doctors Hospital. Both repeaters have increased power outputs as well as new and shorter feed line to the antenna. Additionally, both repeaters are now controlled by an S-COM repeater controller. Please take a

moment to test the operations of these repeaters and let us know your comments using this "<u>Know of Repeater Issues?</u>" link.

The 147.120 KT4N Repeater in Wrens will implement a Tone Squelch of 71.9 Hz on April 1, 2020. The repeater currently transmits a tone of 71.9 allowing all radio operators to go ahead and program a Tone Squelch of 71.9 Hz (Transmit and Receive Tone) into their radios prior to the implementation.

An updated CHIRP codeplug has been placed on the <u>AugustaHam.net</u> website and is available for download and use. There is also an <u>Amateur Calendar</u> with local nets and events.

ARCCC, Inc. needs additional net controllers to add to the rotation of those who run a net each Monday night at 7:30 PM. Training will be provided for those operators who would like to learn how to become a "Net Control Operator". Please contact Devon at KM4PHT[at]outlook.com.
