
- ARCCC, Inc. membership dues

# Field Day 2020 Plan

- One day for K4KNS “in the field” – a learning opportunity!
  - Camp Tanglewood, Saturday, June 27<sup>th</sup>
  - Setup begins at 9 AM, operate 2 PM – 8 PM, teardown complete by 10 PM
  - Fully observing health and safety protocols
  - Meals at nearby restaurants or delivery/carry out
- We encourage everyone to participate in Field Day this year, whether with other members at Camp Tanglewood, or at home with your own station
- Consider setting up a station at home using commercial power (Class D) or emergency power (Class E) with your callsign on Sunday (and Saturday, if you do not join us at Camp Tanglewood)
  - You may use the club repeater(s) for home operators to maintain contact with other club members during the event (please note that repeater contacts do not count as Field Day contacts)
  - You may include that you are affiliated with this club when you submit your personal Field Day entry to ARRL





# Field Day Classes

- Class A
  - Club or non-club portable; group of 3 or more persons
  - Set up specifically for Field Day
  - Must not use facilities installed for permanent station use
  - All club equipment must be within a 1000-ft circle
  - ARCCC, Inc. Field Day operation at Camp Tanglewood will be Class A




# Field Day Classes

- Class B
  - One or two-person portable FD station set up and operated by no more than two persons
  - Most other provisions are the same as Class A
  - Can use emergency power, battery power, & commercial power
- Class C
  - Mobile – stations in vehicles capable of operating while in motion
  - Vehicle does not need to be moving, but must be fully capable of motion without any changes in antenna or station
  - All operators and equipment must be in the same vehicle




# Field Day Classes

- Class D
  - Home stations – operating from permanent station locations
  - Using commercial power
  - [ARRL temporary rule waiver for 2020](#): Class D may work all other Field Day stations, including other Class D stations, for points
- Class E
  - Home Stations – operating on emergency power
  - Same as Class D, except using emergency power for transmitters and receivers
  - Computers used to make contacts (RTTY, PSK31, FT-8, FT-4, etc.) must be on emergency power too
  - May use commercial power for non-radio operations (lighting, logging computers, Internet, etc.)
  - Class E may work all other Field Day stations for points




# Field Day Classes

- Class F
  - Emergency Operations Center (EOC) – an amateur radio station at an established EOC activated by a club or non-club group
  - May utilize equipment and antennas temporarily or permanently installed at the EOC for the event




# Field Day Exchange

- Station class + max number of simultaneously transmitted signals & [ARRL Section](#)
- Examples:
  - Mobile station in South Carolina: **1C SC**
  - Solo home operation with commercial power in Georgia: **1D GA**
  - Two transmitter home operation using generator in Northern Florida: **2E NFL**
  - Club station with for transmitters in eastern Pennsylvania: **4A PA**




# Logging Your Contacts

- You need to log your FD contacts to [submit an entry for scoring](#)
- Small operations could use a [paper log](#) & “[dupe sheet](#)”
  - [ARRL Section List](#) for reference
- For even a modest operation, you will want to use computer logging software
- FD contest logging software:
  - [N1MM Logger+](#)
    - Free, but somewhat complicated to set up
  - [N3FJP FD Contest Log](#)
    - Costs \$8.95 (online registration), but easy to set up and use
    - ARCCC, Inc. club license does NOT allow members to use club registration for personal use
    - There are other options, such
  - [K4CPO FD Logger](#) – video for Raspberry Pi browser-based FD logging software
- Logging software also makes it much easier for online submission of your contest entry to ARRL





# Submitting your FD Entry

- Use [ARRL's online submission tool](#)
- [Temporary rule waiver for 2020](#) – “an aggregate club score will be published, which will be the sum of all individual entries indicating a specific club.”
- “... individual participants using their own callsigns, can contribute their Field Day scores to the club of their choosing; there's no restriction as to which club they contribute their score to...”
- All participants must use the **same exact club name** in their entry




