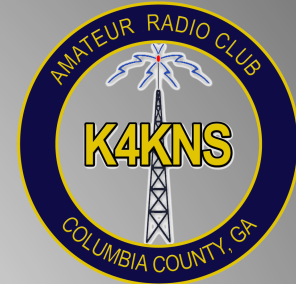
OLD BUSINESS

Some of the qualifications for consideration to determine to winner include, but are not limited to:

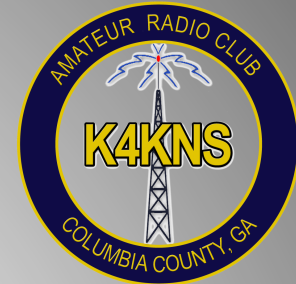
- Donation of significant effort or resources to ARCCC, Inc.

The Board of Directors will hold a vote to select the winners in November

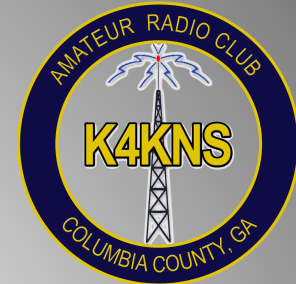
If the club holds a holiday party in December, there will also be a ceremony to present the awards.

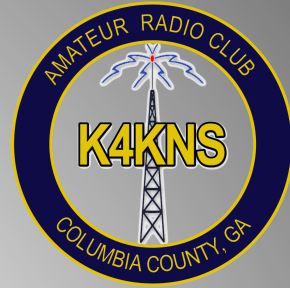

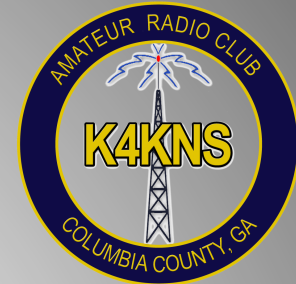
