Minimum eligibility requirements:

- Licensed Amateur Radio Operator
- ARCCC, Inc. member in good standing
- For the Rookie of the Year Award only licensed operator for 3 years or less as of November 1st, 2021

Considerations:

- Active involvement in area ham radio activities
- Donation of significant effort or resources to ARCCC, Inc.
- Visible good example and "ambassador" for Amateur Radio in the community
- Elmer to new hams
- Individual preparedness (examples: emergency training, upgraded license, etc.)
- Regular participant in club meetings and events
- Net participation or Net Control Operator
- Volunteer Examiner and/or Instructor

Current Board of Directors members are not eligible for these awards.






