SITUATION - OVERVIEW:

Grindstone Ministries (GSM) has requested communications support, and specifically AmRRON radio operators, in support of their disaster relief ministry deployment in eastern Tennessee (Jonesborough), in response to catastrophic damage from Hurricane Helene.

GSM has established a Forward Operating Base (FOB) at a Baptist church in the town of Jonesborough, and can billet up to 100 volunteers, and can provide food/water/shelter at the FOB. The FOB is in a grid-up location, with internet, water, and commercial power. Just a half a mile away none of this exists.

Specific requests are for radio operators to provide communications support for teams traveling into remote, mountainous locations in extremely austere conditions. Several area repeaters are non operational, and in many routes and locations that GSM anticipates traveling to have no direct line of sight to repeaters, no cell signal.

FRIENDLY FORCES:

Other ministries and National Guard are said to be operating in the area, and another volunteer organization (Sentinal), which works closely with GSM, are said to be working in the area, but currently operating in Asheville, NC with the use of helicopters.

ATTACHMENTS/DETACHMENTS:

None specified at this time. A regional support team will be established, consisting of AmRRON HF digital mode operators and VHF operators within repeater (or linked repeater) range of the FOB.

The Regional Support Team will act as a support element for radio operators in the AO, and to be a lifeline when there are no other conventional methods of communicating.

MISSION:

Provide unconventional communications support at a fixed site (FOB), and as an RTO (RadioTelephone Operator) attached to disaster relief teams on various missions, to include working cadaver dogs, delivering food/water/aid to remote locations, clearing access routes, etc. Maintain communications with Regional Support Team, SIGCEN Eastern, and AmrRON National, providing periodic SITREPs, STATREPs, and other general correspondence to support the mission.

EXECUTION INTENT:

- Provide HF Digital mode communications link from grid down locations to AmRRON RST, Grindstone Ministries, and other organizations, as necessary.
- Provide VHF voice communications link from grid down locations to AmRRON RST, Grindstone Ministries, and other organizations, as necessary.
- 3. Assist GSM team members with programming and troubleshooting individual and team radio systems.
- 4. Maintain and update communications plan (Signals Annex), and keep AmRRON RSTs updated of same.
- Volunteer AmRRON Deploying operators will be introduced to the RST members and the local GSM Operations Director at the appropriate time.

Distribution: Grindstone FOB; AmRRON Deployment Detachment operators; Regional Support Team operators; Tier 5 & Tier 6 Stations

Area of Operations SITE ASSESSMENT:

Grid Square at FOB: EM86sh

Soil: Rocky to sandy; Unknown ferrous/non-ferrodus composition

Moisture: Near standing water; high water table; previous flooding and precipitation, high moisture content.

Topography: Rolling foothills at FOB, base of mountains; Expected operational area Appalachian mountain range, with steep, mountainous, rugged, and remote terrain. High concentration of communications "dead zones" with no direct line-of-sight to cellular towers or radio repeaters.

Natural antenna/wire support: Buildings and trees in some areas around the FOB.

Manufactured or improvised masts highly recommended.

Estimation of RF performance: Fair to poor, improved in some areas with use of repeaters; Mountain operations will require line of sight to repeaters or HF NVIS radio.

LIMITED DISTRIBUTION

MISSION:

Provide unconventional communications support (primarily) as an RTO (RadioTelephone Operator) attached to disaster relief teams on various missions, to include, but not limited to, working cadaver dogs, delivering food/water/aid to remote locations, clearing access routes, etc., and (secondary) at a fixed site (FOB). and Maintain communications with Regional Support Team, SIGCEN Eastern, and Amrkon National, providing periodic SITREPs, STATREPs, and other general correspondence to support the mission.

ALL COMMUNICATIONS SUPPORT OPERATIONS WILL BE EXECUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AmrRON Mission Statement and Guiding Principles.

EXECUTION:

- DET-D: (AmRRON Communications Detachment Deployed Team)
 - RTO (Radio Telephone Operator Deployed Detachment Operator)
- RST (Regional Support Team)
 - RSTO (Regional Support Team Operator)

RTO will deploy at his own expense and risk to join Grindstone Ministries deployed team at the FOB in Jonesborough, TN. Coordination prior to deployment with John Jacob Schmidt, director of AmrRON. This is to ensure a sustained rotation of operators covering operations for 30 to 90 days.

RTOs will report to Mark Bright (GSM) at the FOB for assignments. Conduct disaster communications support operations in post-Hurricane Helene impact areas in and around Jonesborough, TN.

Operations may extend deep into remote mountainous terrain and isolated communities, requiring RON (Remain Over Night) ops in unforeseen locations throughout the disaster impact area, in neighboring counties and states.

RST will provide support coverage on VHF, HF, or conventional/internet methods (or any combination) as directed and coordinated by the RST Director in Tennessee, Bravo Foxtrot-29.

RSTO will cover assigned shifts to ensure depoyed RTOs maintain a continuous lifeline for the Grindstone teams conducting disaster relief.

Deployment chain of command:

Upon arrival at the FOB and reporting for duty, RTOs will fall under the command and control of the Grindstone FOB chain of command – Specifically Mark Bright, or his designated proxy.

Radio operations chain of command:

Radio Operations will fall under the direction of the Regional Support Team Director, Bravo Foxtrot-29, or his designated proxy, who will be under the direction of AmrRON National.

For radio operations – technical matters and TTPs (Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures) – Radio operators deployed will fall under the direction of the AmRRON S6 (Comms) Director at the FOB, who will fall under the Grindstone FOB Operations Director for duty and mission assignments.

In the absence of a FOB S6 Director, radio operators will fall under the direction of the FOB Operations Director for duty and mission assignments, and under the Regional Support Team Director for technical TTP matters.

All other volunteer supporting AmRRON operators, to include Tier 4, Tier 5, and Regional Net Coordinators, will fall under the direction of the Regional Support Team Director.

RTOs will be required to check in with the RST (Regional Support Team) every three hours during daylight hours, or otherwise when operational with a disaster relief team as the team RTO.

RTOs will check in by any method available, but the primary method will be via HF radio, digital modes.

- *HF digital mode: DEMONSTRATED PROFICIENCY with minimum FLDIGI, FLMSG, FLAMP with AmrRON Custom Forms; Preferably also JS8Call and VARA mode operations (Winlink/PAT and/or vARIM).
- **Stay Behind Operations: These missions require an RTO stay at a fixed location to provide communications from very remote sites, under the most austere conditions for multiple days at a time, without returning to the FOB at the end of each day. In these cases, the operator will be supported with sustenance (food, water, shelter) via resupply.

For sending text message from email (Winlink or PAT connection to a Winlink node) over radio. You must have the phone number, and you must know the wireless carrier, in order to send a text from email. DO NOT USE THIS UNLESS REAL WORLD EMERGENCY, as Winlink posts all content to their website.

























The standard format for reporting enemy information is the SALUTE report. SALUTE is an acronym that stands for Size, Activity, Location, Unit identification, Time, and **Equipment**. The report body should be brief, accurate, and clear. Facts and opinions are distinguished.
